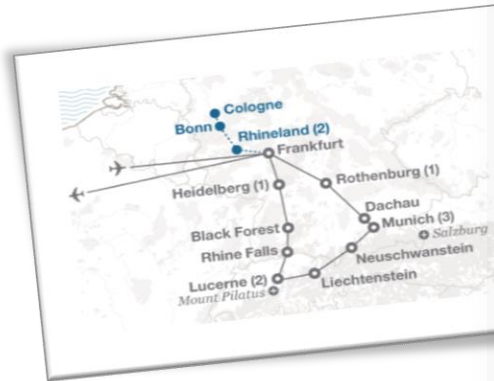
ILEAD Seminars-
